LOCATION:

• Eastern Europe, bordered by Ukraine (N and E), Republic of Moldova (NE), the Black Sea (SE), Bulgaria (S), Serbia (SW) and Hungary (NW);

AREA:

• 237.500 sq. km (land: 230,340 sq. km and water: 7.160 sq. km);

CLIMATE:

• Temperate continental (cold, cloudy winters with snow and fog; sunny hot summers with showers and sometimes thunderstorms);

NATIONAL HOLIDAY:

• Unification Day (of Romania and Transylvania): December 1st (1918);

OFFICIAL LANGUAGE:

• Romanian;

POPULATION:

• 21,528,627 (as of January 2009);

ETHNIC GROUPS:

 Romanians 89.5%, Hungarians 6.6%, Roma 2.5%, Ukrainians 0.3%, Germans 0.3%, Russians 0.2%, Turks 0.2%, other 0.4% (2002 census);

• Textiles and footwear, light machinery and auto assembly, mining, timber, construction materials, metallurgy, chemicals, food processing, petroleum refining;

• The main foreign languages used in Romania are English, French and German;

• The metric system (since 1866);

VISA:

• Foreign visitors need a valid passport and, depending on the country of citizenship, a visa (obtainable at Romanian diplomatic and consular offices as well as at the frontier, including airports). Multiple entry visas are also available for frequent travelers to Romania. There is a nominal fee to be paid to get the visa. Romania joined the EU on January 1st, 2007.

ROMANIAN PERSONALITIES SCIENCE and TECHNOLOGY

INVENTORS:

• Petrache POENARU - inventor of the world's first fountain pen.

TECHNOLOGY:

- Henri COANDĂ builder of the world's first jet powered aircraft;
- Traian VUIA inventor of the first self-propelling heavier-than-air aircraft (1906);
- Aurel VLAICU engineer, inventor, airplane constructor and early pilot;
- Spiru HARET mathematician, astrologer and pedagogue; he made a fundamental contribution to the n-body problem in celestial mechanics by proving that using a third degree approximation for the disturbing forces implies instability of the major axes of the orbits, and by introducing the concept of secular perturbations in relation to this;
- Anghel SALIGNY engineer; built the first silos of reinforced concrete, in the world.

IT:

- George CONSTANTINESCU engineer, inventor; he founded the Theory of Sonics, based on which he developed a number of applications including a synchronization gear;
- Ştefan ODOBLEJA philosopher, doctor, writer; one of the fathers of cybernetics; he established many of the major themes of cybernetics regarding cybernetics and systems thinking ten years before the work of Norbert Wiener was published in 1948.

MEDICINE:

- Ana ASLAN inventor of Gerovital, an anti-aging product widely used by famous personalities, such as Charles de Gaulle, John F. Kennedy, Indira Gandhi, Charlie Chaplin or Salvador Dalí.
- Carol DAVILA doctor, pharmacist; he invented the Davila tincture used for the treatment of cholera
- Nicolae PĂULESCU discoverer of insulin (1922)

BIOLOGY:

- Adrian BEJAN mechanical engineer; inventor of the constructal theory of generation of design in nature;
- George Emil PALADE doctor, discoverer of the ribosomes; the first Romanian to win the Nobel Prize;
- Emil RACOVIȚĂ biologist, speologist, the founder of biospeleology

CHEMESTRY:

- Lazăr EDELEANU the first chemist to synthesize amphetamine;
- Mircea SABĂU Romanian-American physicist specialized in Nuclear Medicine renowned for his contributions to medical imaging and neutron studies.

PHYSICS:

• Horia HULUBEI - the first physicist in the world to obtain X-ray spectra in gases.

GYMNASTICS:

- Nadia COMĂNECI the world-famous gymnast from Romania, being accredited as the greatest gymnast of the 20th century; the first gymnast to be awarded a perfect score of 10;
- Simona AMÂNAR a Romanian former gymnast, seven-time Olympic medalist and ten-time world medalist;
- Maria OLARU retired Olympic artistic gymnast from Romania. She is an Olympic, World, and European gold medalist in a team;
- Marius Daniel URZICĂ Olympic champion, three-time world champion and three-time European champion on pommel horse;
- Octavian Ioan Atanase BELLU head of the Romanian national women's artistic gymnastics team. Highly successful, Bellu led the team to five World and two Olympic titles.

TENNIS:

- Ilie NĂSTASE former professional tennis player, one of the world's top players of the 1970, being the world no 1 tennis player in 1972 and 1973. He was inducted into the International Tennis Hall of Fame in 1991
- Ion ȚIRIAC professional tennis player, was elected in 2013 into the International Tennis Hall of Fame
- Virginia RUZICI former professional tennis player from Romania. She is perhaps most notable for winning the 1978 French Open singles championship
- Simona HALEP Romanian professional tennis player who is currently ranked world No. 3 (World top 10 Romanian professional tennis playe)

FOOTBALL:

- Gheorghe HAGI famous Romanian football player
- László BÖLÖNI Romanian football manager and former player. One of the all-time greatest Romanian midfielders, Bölöni was a box-to-box midifielder well known for his passing range, hard working nature and powerful shot from distance
- Miodrag BELODEDICI retired footballer who spent the majority career with Steaua Bucureşti (ten seasons), winning the European Cup with that team and Red Star Belgrade, thus becoming the first player to win the trophy with two different clubs
- Marius LĂCĂTUŞ He was the first player to score in the penalty shoot-out of the 1986 European Cup final against FC Barcelona, won by Steaua
- Mircea LUCESCU former footballer and present manager. He is currently a manager of Ukrainian Premier League side Shakhtar Donetsk with whom he won the UEFA Cup 2008–09

ATHLETICS:

- Gabriela SZABO retired Romanian runner. She competed in the 1500 m and 5000 m events at the 1996 and 2000 Olympics, and won a gold, a silver and a bronze medal
- Iolanda BALAŞ former Romanian athlete, Olympic champion and world record holder in high jump

BOXING:

- Mihai LEU Boxer
- Lucian BUTE former IBF super middleweight champion and former #1 super middleweight in the world by The Ring
- Leonard Dorin DOROFTEI former boxer and WBA Lightweight World Champion
- Francisc VAŞTAG was the first Romanian boxer to win the supreme belt in his category

TIMIŞOARA

FACTS and FIGURES

Timişoara, the fourth largest city in Romania, has the charm of a small town and the opportunities of a big city. Situated in the western part of the country, Timişoara is the capital of Timiş County, which borders Serbia and Hungary. About 350,000 people make their home in the Timişoara area.

SHORT HISTORY

T IS BELIEVED THAT ancient Dacian and Roman settlements existed in this region, but Timişoara was first mentioned in a document of 1212, the "Diploma" of the Hungarian King Andrew II. Since 1342 it has been referred to as a town;

The city has had a turbulent history, being the last rampart against the Turks, who conquered it in 1552, ruling until 1716, when it was conquered by the Austrian armies under the command of Prince Eugene of Savoy;

During the 19th century, Timişoara underwent important industrial development. It was the first European city to introduce electrical street lighting in 1884. Later that decade, in 1899, electric trams also appeared. Through continuous progress, Timişoara has emerged as a modern industrial city;

In 1989, Timişoara was the first city to rise against the communist regime, a revolution that soon spread to other cities and led to important political changes in the country;

At present, the economy of Timişoara is based on the principles of market economy.



CULTURE

IMIŞOARA has a number of outstanding monuments and buildings: the Orthodox Cathedral, the Roman Catholic Dome, the Huniade Castle, the Statue of "St. Nepomuk", the Old Town Hall, the "Bastion" (the rampart of the old city), the "Dicasterial" Palace and the Union Square. Due to these architectural masterpieces, Timişoara is also known as "Little Vienna";

Timişoara is the only European city that features three public theatres in three different languages (Romanian, German and Hungarian) and an Opera, in the same historical building. There are many art galleries in the city.

PEOPLE

IMIŞOARA is a multicultural city where many others nationalities live side by side with the Romanians: Germans, Hungarians, Serbs, Jews, etc. The city is permeated with a spirit of ethnic and religious tolerance. To meet the needs of this cosmopolitan environment, schools provide education in several languages: Romanian, English, French, German, Hungarian and Serbian;

ENVIRONMENT

IMIŞOARA features numerous parks and gardens, and therefore it has often been called "the city of flowers". Because of the temperate climate, recreational outdoor activities take place all year round. Facilities for winter sports are also available within a short distance from the city.

The city is an important academic centre where students may chose from the courses of four public universities: the West University of Timişoara, the Polytechnic University, the University of Medicine and Pharmacy and the "Banat" University of Agricultural Sciences;

Timişoara is a modern cosmopolitan city with strives for: *unity in diversity*. We are diverse, but united in the goal of accomplishing the major ideals of welfare, progress and understanding.



- 1728 works on the Bega river began, making it the first waterway in Romania;
- 1745 the first public hospital is built in Romania (24 years before Vienna and 34 years before Budapest);
- 1753 third city of the Habsbourg Empire with a permanent theater season (after Vienna and Budapest);
- **1760** first city of the Austro-Hungarian Empire with street oil lamps;

- 1815 the first public library in the Eastern part of the Habsbourg Empire;

- **1867** the first city in Romania with horse-drawn trams;
- 1869 the first city in Romania to use waterways;

- 1895 the first city with asphalt pavement in Romania;
- 1899 the first city with electric trams in Romania;
- **1902** the first football match played in Romania.
- 1921 Dura the first street lamp factory in Romania;
- 1928 FC Ripensia the first professional football club in Romania;
- 1938 the first track welding machine in the world, invented by Professor Corneliu Miclos;
- 1953 the only European town with three state theatres in three languages: Romanian, Hungarian and German;
- 1961 the first Romanian electronic computer (created by the Polytechnic Institute of Timişoara);
- 1969 the first encyclopedic treatise on functional equations in the world (created by Professor Mihail Ghermănescu);
- **1989** the first free city in Romania, upon the collapse of the communist dictatorship;



- 1992 the first laparoscopic surgery in gynecology and the first breast plastic surgery (by Professor Ioan Munteanu in collaboration with the Gynecologic Clinic of Heidelberg);
- 1993 the first total hysterectomy by laparoscopy (by Professor Ioan Munteanu in collaboration with the Clinic of Kiel);
- 1995 the first in vitro fertilization and transfer of human embryo made in Romania; the opening of the first Center of Laparoscopy, laparoscopic surgery and in vitro fertilization;
- 1996 birth of Romania's first baby conceived by in vitro fertilization, the first embryo transfer to a surrogate mother (performed by professor Ioan Munteanu's team);
- 2000 the first Romanian city to put forward a social and economic development strategy (a project of the City Hall of Timişoara);
- 2001 the first Romanian city with an info-stand network (a project of the City Hall of Timişoara);
- 2001 the first public audience in Romania (organised by the City Council of Timişoara);
- 2002 the first Romanian city to adopt online tax payment;
- 2002 the City Hall Monitor the first newsletter published by a city hall and handed out free of charge to the citizens;
- 2003 the first Romanian city to broadcast the meetings of the city council online;

- 2003 the first transplantation of hematopoietic stem cells for the regeneration of the cardiac muscle on a patient who suffered a myocardial infarction (the first intervention of this kind in Eastern Europe, performed by dr. Ştefan Drăgulescu's team);
- 2011 The Association "Timişoara European Capital of Culture", founded in order to prepare and support the Municipality's application for the title of the European Capital of Culture in 2021;
- 2013 JAZZ[™] First Edition: a jazz festival that could be one of the most important cultural events in this part of Europe, as the joint effort to achieve the title of European Capital of Culture 2021;
- 2015 WUT is the first University from Romania that founded a permanent establishment in Brussels, where grants for major research projects and education are funded; 23





CENTRAL UNIVERSITY LIBRARY



HE UNIVERSITY Library of Timişoara was established on December 30th, 1944 by a royal decree signed by King Michael I. At first, collections consisted of books and journals of mathematics and physics, but after 1956, when the Faculty of Letters was founded, the Library got an encyclopedic character and grew richer and richer.

In 1992, the University Library of Timişoara became the Central University Library, an institution of national interest, having legal personality and being independent from the university, identical to the Central University Libraries of Bucharest, Iaşi and Cluj. The new status enabled it to become one of the most modern and best equipped academic libraries of Romania.

Since February 8th, 2000, the Central University Library of Timişoara has been officially bearing the name of "Eugen Todoran", the rector of the University who supported it to become the Central University Library.

On October 1st, 2008, the extension building of the Library was inaugurated. It is a modern

edifice, with large comfortable reading rooms, in which collections are displayed on open shelves and organized by study subjects. In the same year, the Library implemented the RFID system (Radio Frequency Identification) in an integrated solution with ALEPH 500. This system allows protection of the publications, their retrieval and their location on the right shelf, their check out and check in by selfcheck.

Along with the Central University Libraries of Bucharest, Iaşi and Cluj, "Eugen Todoran" Central University Library of Timişoara is a scientific and cultural institution of national interest, having a clear mission and a definite role of setting up, organizing, processing, developing and preserving collections of books, periodicals, articles, electronic publications, as well as of creating the information environment necessary for the promotion of educational and research activities, strengthening the part that books play in the scientific and cultural life of the academic milieu.

- There is a two-week Christmas holiday, one-week inter-semestrial holiday, and a two-month summer holiday.


